Day Care Study

Our day care at the Maples has recently been visited by Dr. Jane M Robertson, Lecturer in Dementia Studies at Stirling University.



Jane is conducting a project about dementia day services, focusing on user and carer experiences. The project hopes that their findings will inform the delivery of better day care services for people with memory problems across Scotland and Europe.

We will let you know of the outcomes at the end of the study.

Tartan Design Project

Alzheimer Scotland has been working in conjunction with Paul Rogers who is a Professor at the Arts and Humanities Research Council to design an Alzheimer Scotland tartan.

Paul has visited many of our Services Users at various sites across Scotland holding "Digital Workshops" to help people design a pattern and then producing a physical version by using different colours of ribbon.
