




### **Falkirk Day Care Services**

We have our next Post Diagnostic Group & Carers Information Sessions starting 26<sup>th</sup> April. This is based at the Ironworks Business Centre in Falkirk.

The PDS Group course is for people living with a diagnosis of dementia and their partner, relative or friend who provides them with support.

Local events across Forth Valley will be shared with you through our May/June What's on Guides also.


### **Dementia Helpline**
